

# Preliminary Exam Pattern & Syllabus

The Prelims Exam is OMR-based and consists of multiple-choice questions (MCQs).

## Marking Scheme:

- **1 mark** for every correct answer.
- **Negative marking of 0.33 marks** for each incorrect/multiple answer.
- The **question paper language: English only**.
- Candidates securing **50% or more** marks in the **Prelims** and **40% or more** in the **Gujarati Language Test** (if required) will qualify for the **Mains Exam**.
